What is our Mission?

Rebuilding Together Yellowstone County is an annual effort to assist low-income families, elderly, and disabled homeowners with light maintenance or minor home repairs. All of the home repairs are free to the homeowners with the labor and building materials typically donated by businesses or purchased at discounted prices. All homeowners and their family members are encouraged to help out or volunteer during the Rebuilding Together workday.

How are the Rebuilding Together homes selected?

Applications for the Rebuilding Together Yellowstone County program are solicited from individual homeowners as well as some referrals sought through community service organizations. A committee prioritizes each Rebuilding Together application based upon home repairs, homeowner needs, availability of building materials, along with qualifications of the volunteer labor pool. Skilled trades persons and/or building contractors will also assess the home repairs or required building skills and materials that will be necessary for each property before a final decision is made for selection of a Rebuilding Together Yellowstone County home or project.

Who can be a Rebuilding Together Volunteer?

Rebuilding Together Yellowstone County volunteers come from businesses, church groups, service organizations, schools, community clubs, professional associations, and other caring individuals. Anyone who is age 14 or older and is willing to lend a helping hand can volunteer to help on our Rebuilding Together workday. Whether you're a novice or a pro, Rebuilding Together Yellowstone County can use your help. All individuals are welcome. What other ways or How can you help Rebuilding Together?

Sponsor a House
